



## WHAT IS PARTNERSHIP SCHOOLS IRELAND?

The Partnership Schools Ireland (PSI) programme aims to ensure better outcomes for children by promoting partnerships between schools, families and the wider community. It works by bringing the whole school community together to plan and work on agreed activities.

Schools form an Action Team for Partnerships (ATP) to drive this work. The ATP is made up of the Principal, other school staff, students, parents and members of the wider community.

The ATP receives free training and ongoing support that gives them the skills and guidance needed to work together, set goals and improve outcomes for children.
